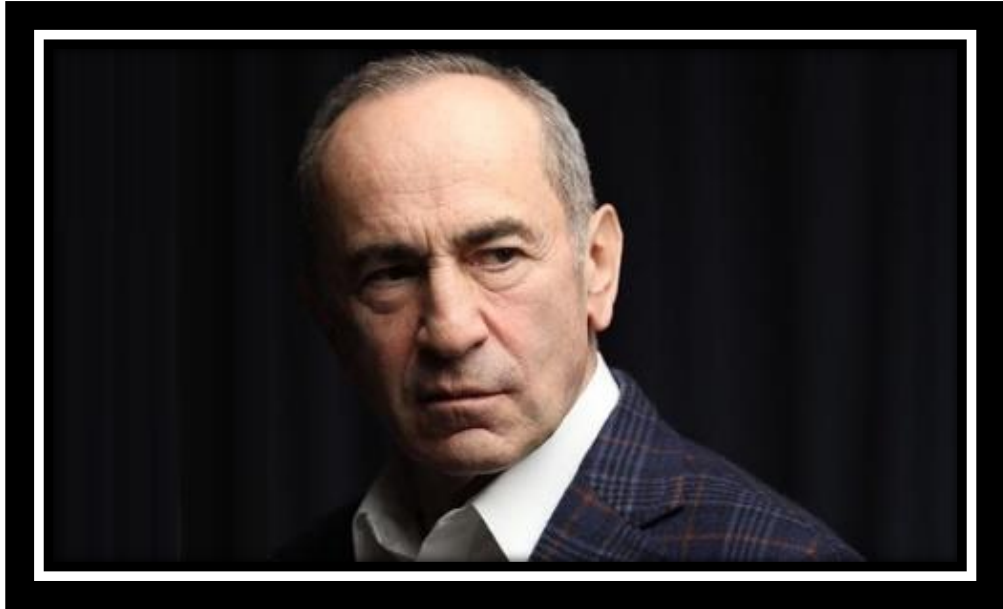

¹ Conversebank came to the attention of the US intelligence services when it turned out that through its accounts huge sum of money (about 800-900 millionUSD) was laundered by a number of companies and banks associated with international terrorism. The scandal led to the resignation of the bank's president S. Nasibyan and the sale of Kocharyan family's assets to another owner E. Ernekyan. However, there are sufficient grounds to believe that the deal on the sale of S. Kocharyan's stake was false. In reality, he remains a co-owner of Converse Bank

During 2017-2018 Robert Kocharyan received about 213 million AMD from various legal entities and transferred an amount equivalent to 486 million 600 thousand drams for bonds and securities. During the same period he deposited about 95 million 600 thousand drams into his accounts withdrawing 13 million drams in cash. During 2017-2018 he invested an amount equivalent to about 2 billion 77 million AMD as a deposit and withdrew an amount equivalent to 2 billion 400 million AMD from his accounts.

During 2017-2018 Sedrak Kocharyan received an amount equal to 1 billion 537 million AMD from various individuals and legal entities, and has transferred to different accounts an amount equal to about 855 million AMD. He deposited about 191 million AMD in cash into his accounts. In the same period he made a deposit of an amount equal to 2 billion 259 million drams and withdrew an amount equal to 2 billion 172 million drams from his accounts. In 2008 he purchased securities in the amount of 145 million 100 thousand AMD.

During the same period, he deposited cash equal to about 459 million AMD in his account and withdrew 141 million AMD from his accounts.

In 2017, it invested an amount equal to 440 million AMD as deposit to his accounts. In 2017-2018 he withdrew an amount equal to 580 million AMD from his accounts.

State property alienated by Robert Kocharyan (1998-2008)

1. Zvartnots International Airoport

July, 2002 the Government of the Republic of Armenia and Corporacion America, signed an agreement according to which Zvartnots International Airport was transferred to concession management of Armenia International Airports for 30 years. The deal was valued at \$ 2.8 billion.

2. Zangezur Copper-Molybdenum Combine CJSC

Zangezur Copper-Molybdenum Combine was privatized by the decision of the government on December 14, 2004. The controlling stake in the company (60%) passed to the German "Cronimet" company, 15% - to the "Plant of Pure Iron" OJSC, 12,5% to "Armenian molibden production" and 12,5% "Zangezur mining" LLC.

3. Armenia Hotel

After the collapse of the Soviet Union in 25-01-1997 in order to privatize the hotel by the decision N 210 of the Government of the Republic of Armenia, a commission was set up with the following members: Armen Darbinayin / Chairman /, Garnik Nanagulyan, Vahram Avanesyan u Prime Minister of the Republic of Armenia Robert Kocharyan. In 1998 Robert Kocharyan becoming the President made a decision and 80% of the share of "Armenia" hotel was sold. After the sale, there were announcements in the press and National Assembly that Garnik Nanagulyan had received a bribe of 1 million USD and Armen Darbinyan bought an apartment abroad for \$ 700,000. No international competition took place. In the result of this dirty and corrupted deal RA has lost more than 16 million US dollars, and more than 560 employees of the hotel staff lost their jobs. The hotel was acquired by AK Development and renamed to Armenia Marriott Hotel Yerevan.

4. Yerjan Brandy Factory

In 1998 Yerevan brandy factory was privatized and joined "Pernod Ricard" international group. The deal cost \$ 30 million

5. ArmenTel

August, 1997 the "Telephone Network of Armenia" enterprise was dissolved and merged with "ArmenTel". It was put up for auction in 1998. The Armenian government expeditedly sold its shares to the Greek company OTE. The deal was worth \$ 205 million.

6. Sevan -Hrazdan –Jrar CJSC

Sevan -Hrazdan –Jrar CJSC was transferred to Russian Inter RAO holding instead debts for nuclear fuel

7.Hrazdan Terminal Power Plant

Hrazdan Terminal Power Plant was transferred to Russia on the agreement signed on 17,07, 2002

8.Mathematical Research Enterprise

Mathematical Research Enterprise was transferred to Russia on the agreement signed on 17,07, 2002

9. "Property for debt"

MARS plant was transferred to Russia on the agreement signed on 17,07, 2002 and was renamed to MARS RAO

10.“Materials Science” Research And Production Institute passed to Russia on the agreement signed on 17,07, 2002

Hrazdan Terminal Power Plant, Mathematical Research Enterprise, MARS plant and “Materials Science” Research And Production Institute were passed to Russia in the frame of the most corruptive deal initiated by Kocharyan, called “Property for debt” instead of \$ 98 million

10. "Electric Networks of Armenia" CJSC

CJSC "Electric Networks of Armenia" was registered in April 1997 in Yerevan and - after the accession three regional electric networks in May 2002 (CJSC "Northern Electric Network", CJSC "South Electric Network" and CJSC "Central Electric Network") - was privatized in November 2002 and sold 100% of its shares to Midland Resources Holding Ltd.

In June 2005, on the basis of an agreement between Interenergo B.V. and Midland Resources Holding Ltd. CJSC Electric Networks of Armenia came under the control of the INTER RAO UES group, and in June 2006, 100% of the company's shares were acquired by Interenergo BV, a subsidiary of INTER RAO UES OJSC (at the time of purchase - CJSC), and since September 2015 year 100% of the company's shares came under the control of the Tashir Group.

11.Armenian Railways

On 13 February 2008, the Government of Armenia signed an agreement to transfer 100% of the state-owned Armenian Railways to Russian Railways.

1998-2008 Political Assassinations



Henrik Khachatryan. Prosecutor General of the Republic of Armenia. He was shot dead in his office in 1998, on August 6. According to the official version, he was killed by former RA Transport Prosecutor Aram Karapetyan who immediately shot himself after killing Henrik Khachatryan



Aram Karapetyan. Former RA Prosecutor of Transport. An hour after the incident, Robert Kocharyan "revealed" the crime, according to which Aram Karapetyan shot and killed Prosecutor General Henrik Khachatryan and committed suicide. It was this "discovery" that later became the main version of the investigative group and the crime was considered revealed.



Vahram Khorkhoruni. RA Deputy Minister of Defense, Colonel. He was shot dead on December 10, 1998, in the lobby of his apartment. The murder has not been revealed.



Artsrun Margaryan. RA Deputy Minister of Internal Affairs and National Security, Major General. He was killed in 1999, on February 9. According to the official version, he committed suicide with two shots, once shooting in the head, once in the heart



Vazgen Sargsyan. RA Prime Minister. He was killed on October 27, 1999, in the NA hall by Nairi Hunanyan's criminal group. The organizers of the October 27 terrorist attack have not been identified.



Karen Demirchyan. NA Speaker, Chairman of the National Party of Armenia (PPA). He was killed on October 27, 1999 by Nairi Hunanyan's criminal gang.



Yuri Bakhshyan. NA Deputy Speaker. He was killed in 1999. October 27, by Nairi Hunanyan's criminal group. No organizers revealed.



Ruben Miroyan. NA Deputy Speaker. He was killed in 1999. October 27, by Nairi Hunanyan's criminal group.



Leonard Petrosyan. RA Minister of Operative Affairs. He was killed in 1999. October 27, by Hunanyan's group.



Armenak Armenakyan. RA NA Deputy. He was killed in 1999. on October 27. The murder has not been revealed.



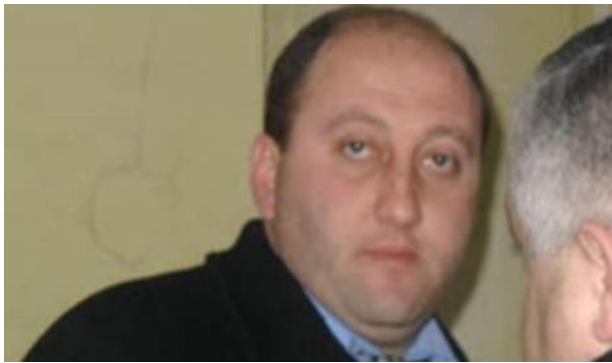
Henrik Abrahamyan. Deputy of the National Assembly. He was killed on October 27, 1999 by Nairi Hunanyan's criminal gang



Mikael Kotanyan. NA Deputy, Academician. He was killed in 1999. October 27, by Hunanyan's group. NA Speaker Armen Khachatryan's bodyguard Arbak Babasyan killed a 30-35-year-old citizen with a gun at the intersection of Baghramyan and Kievyan streets on April 4, 2000, at around 02:40.



Gagik Poghosyan. Adviser to the Prime Minister of the Republic of Armenia, Head of the Prime Minister's Control Service. He was killed in 2001. On September 11, a grenade exploded in the door of his apartment. The murder has not been revealed.



Poghos Poghosyan. Citizen of Georgia. He was killed in 2001. He was beaten by Kocharyan's bodyguards on September 25 at the Aragast cafe to greet the president with the phrase "Hi Rob." A few days after the murder, R. Kocharyan stated that if Poghos Poghosyan was alive, he would still have something to say. One of the bodyguards, A. Harutyunyan, nicknamed Kuku who was sentenced only to two years probation. It has to be mentioned

that Kocharyan and Poghosyan were friends during their study and Kocharyan lived for a long time at his place during study.



Tigran Naghdalyan. Journalist, Chairman of the Public Television and Radio Council. He was shot dead on December 28, 2002, on the porch of his parents' house

1998-2008 Assassinations of Officials



Ashot Mkhitarian. Director of "Arzni" branch of electric networks. Armen Keshishyan, the mayor of Nor Hachn on, fired six shots in the presence of two police officers and killed him. On September 24,2005. Keshishyan was sentenced to only 3.5 years in prison and was soon released on parole



Tigran Petrosyan. The mayor of Dalar village, Ararat region. He was killed in 2006. August 30, by the former mayor village Gegham Babayan with a hunting rifle.



Roland Mkrtychyan. Mayor of Nalbandyan village, Armavir region. 2006 On the night of December 20, he was called out of his house by unknown people and killed.



Shahen Hovasapyan. Head of the operative-intelligence department of the RA State Tax Service. He was killed in 2006. On the morning of September 6, while traveling to work in an official car. An unknown assailant detonated a bomb placed under his seat

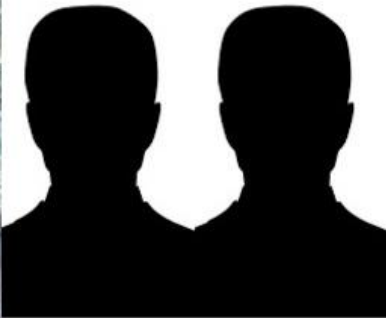


2007 On the night of August 25, 2012, on his way home from office , Lori Region Prosecutor Albert Ghazaryan was killed by an unknown person near his house.



2007 The chairman of the Hunters' Union of Armenia, the coordinator of the Kanaker area of the Kanaker-Zeytun community of the Prosperous Armenia Party, was killed by unknown near the Arabkir market on November 8, 1960. born Sayad Davtyan.

1998-2008 Scandalous Criminal Murders



Vanush Torosyan. Director of "Dvin" hotel. He was killed in 2003. He was shot in Moscow on August 31. Dionis Margaryan, a former co-chair of the Union of Liberation War Veterans, a retired police colonel, and Valery Avanesyan, a former employee of the RA Ministry of Internal Affairs and an employee of the Moscow City Department of Internal Affairs were killed with him.



2005 Mher Ter-Hovhannisyan was killed in a shootout on February 4.



Rafael Shahmuradyan. Representative of "Avtovaz" in Armenia, head of "Armenia-Lada" company. He was killed in 2005. He was born on February 6 in the Samara region of Russia, on the way to the city of Togliatti. A year earlier, on May 24, an assassination attempt was made against Shahmuradyan on Baghramyan Avenue in Yerevan, near the Barekamutyun metro station. An unknown person fired at him from a "Niva" car, after which Shahmuradyan miraculously survived. The bullet did not damage any organ while passing through the body. At that time, Shahmuradyan stated that he suspected the RA Minister of Communication and Transport Andranik Manukyan in the assassination attempt against him.



Levon Gulyan. Former owner of "Pandok" restaurant. 2007 On the night of May 9, 2010, at 3:00 am, he was taken to the Shengavit police station in connection with the murders of Ashot, Stepan, who were related during 2006-2007, and later Artavazd Vardanyan, who were killed during 2006-2007. Gulyan was detained at the police station for two days, which ended with Gulyan falling from a police window under suspicious circumstances and dying. According to the official version, he allegedly wanted to escape and fell from the second floor and died.



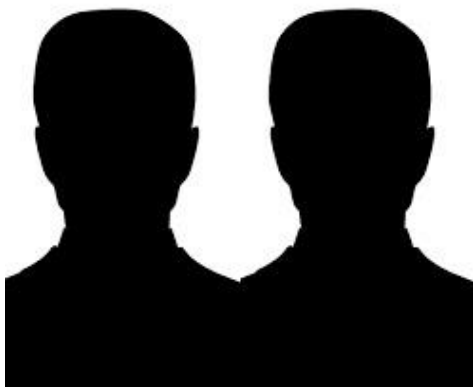
Sedrak Zatikyan. Son of Vahan Zatikyan, former head of the Malatia-Sebastia community of Yerevan. He was killed on June 22, 2006, in broad daylight, in front of dozens of people, at the intersection of Sebastia-Tichina streets. A passer-by, Karine Sargsyan, born in 1969, was also killed by the bullets fired by the murderer.



Alexander Givoyev, businessman. He was killed in 2006. on August 8 on the Ashtarak-Gyumri highway while shopping. Saleswoman Gyulnara Karapetyan was also killed by the bullets fired by the killers.



August 6, 2007 ,in the village of Arinj, Kotayk region, the employees of the "Multi Group" Concern security service G. Balyan and A. Andriasyan were first beaten and then shot and killed by Denis Yermolov, an officer of the Russian Armed Forces stationed in Armenia.



2007 On the night of August 12, 2012, an unknown person stabbed Artak Aleksanyan and Arthur Simonyan near the "Relax" disco club. Later they died at the hospital. There were publications in the press that the son of RA Prime Minister Serzh Sargsyan's brother, was also involved in the murder.
